Introduction

- Moses going into the mountain to meet God.
 - Sin of the people.
 - Judgment of the sin.
 - Each man responsible before God for his decision.
- I. Why is it necessary to ask who is on the Lord’s side?
- A. The world is just as bent on sinning today.
 - 1. Men are still building their idols
 - 2. Refusing to accept the blame for their sin
 - 3. Many are harden sinners against God
 - 4. Many are indifferent – Joshua and Elijah had to ask the same question
 - 5. Many professing Christians are luke warm and God will spew them out
 - B. There is a conflict between God and Satan and you must choose
 - 1. Jesus made it clear that Satan controls this world
 - 2. All have sinned since Adam’s fall
 - 3. Men must choose whom they will serve
 - 4. Jesus said there is no middle ground – You cannot straddle the fence
- II. Who is on the Lord’s side?
- A. Those who have turned from their idols – Matthew 6:24
 - B. Those who will deny themselves and take up their cross – Luke 9:23
 - C. Those who will love God and others – Luke 10:27
- III. Why be on the Lord’s side?
- A. Because Satan is a tyrant and will destroy you.
 - B. Because God will liberate you and give you – peace; joy; and abundant life
 - C. Because God’s side stands for all that is good; for you and for others

- D. Because God's side will bring victory now
- E. Because God's side will bring rewards in eternity as well

IV. When should we be on the Lord's Side?

- A. Now because you don't know what tomorrow holds
- B. Now because it is not God's will that any should perish
- C. As surely as the people had choose before Moses you must choose today before God and this assembly
- D. God gives you the freedom to choose but also the responsibility for your choice.
