- I. Jude’s reference to himself “The Servant”
 - a. Relationship to James
 - b. Relationship to Jesus yet he called himself a servant
 - c. James referred to himself as a servant of the Lord Jesus Christ
 - d. Peter and Paul also claimed only to be servants of Jesus
