- I. Paul speaks of the last night of Jesus
 - A. He said I must keep the Passover with you
 - B. He kept the old but gave it a new meaning
 - 1. The bread represented His Body Scriptures
 - 2. The cup of juice represented His Blood Scriptures
- II. As often as you do this you do so
 - A. His death
 - B. It is to be done by believers until His Return
 - C. It is declaration of our faith
 - D. It is a witness unto the World
- III. Don't take it unworthily
 - A. Examine Yourself
 - 1. Do you have the salvation of Jesus?
 - a. If not it will mean the damnation of your soul
 - b. You have mocked the blessed Savior
 - c. Paul makes it plain it will not save you
 - d. Only repentance and faith in Jesus can save you
 - 2. Judge yourself even if you are a Christian.
 - a. The Old Testament taught this
 - b. The New Testament teaches this
 - c. With this cleansing
 - i. Precious fellowship is enjoyed
 - ii. Blessing comes to the Christian
 - d. If we don't judge ourselves God will
 - i. We will not be condemned with this world.
 - ii. In God's chastening many find force brought into their lives to bring them back to Him (ex. Weakness, sickness, some sleep, etc.)
