- I. He is able to keep you from falling.
 - A. In verse one Jude tells us Jesus is able to preserve us or keep us.
 - B. Then he discusses the apostate or mere professors.
 - C. Now as he closes out this epistle he tells us again that Jesus is able to keep us from falling.
 - D. We are promised eternal life or everlasting life.

 - E. Jesus said no man can take us out of His hands or God’s hands.

 - B. Only in the blood of the Lamb is their cleansing. 1 Peter 1:18-19
 - C. Propitiation for us. (We stand in Jesus’ righteousness.) Romans 3:22-25
 - D. Jude says that with joy Jesus will present the redeemed to the Father.
