

“Blind as a Bat”



John 8:1-12

Jesus is “*the light of the world*” (v. 12).

- **This was a statement about GOOD (light) vs. EVIL (darkness).**
- **Jesus introduced people to HIS DIVINE AUTHORITY to forgive sin.**

**#2 Four groups of people
had their sin exposed by
*“the light of the world”.***

- **The crowd that gathered
to hear Jesus teach (v. 2).**
- **Light exposes the sin of
people on THE
PERIPHERY.**

- **The Pharisees and scribes (vv. 3-9).**
- **Light exposes the sin of people with a STONE IN THEIR HAND.**
- **Their INTOLERANCE OF GRACE was worse than her IMMORALITY.**

- **The man also caught in the act of adultery.**
- **Light exposes the sin of people who think they LIVE ABOVE THE LAW.**

- **The woman brought before Jesus (vv. 10-11).**
- **Light exposes the sin of people who want to WALK IN THE LIGHT.**
